Scale of Charges for the Heidelberg University Master Program Advanced Physical Methods in Radiotherapy

Based on Sec. 2 para. 2 and 13 para. 1 of the State Law Governing University, and Other Institutes of Higher Education Fees (Landeshochschulgebührengesetz) of 01January 2005 (Law Gazette (GBl.) pp. 1, 56 et seqq.), last amended by Art. 7 of the Act of 03 December 2008 (GBl. pp. 435, 457), in conj. w. Sec. 19 para. 1 no. 10 of the State Law Governing University, and Other Institutes of Higher Education Fees of 01 January 2005 (GBl. pp. 1 et seqq.), last amended by Art. 2 of the Act of 03 December August 2008 (GBI. p. 435), in conjunction with Sec. 11 of the Rules of Procedure of Ruprecht-Karls-University in Heidelberg, the Senate of Heidelberg University on 24 November 2009 by way of a summary decision made by the Rector, has adopted the following Statutes. The Rector has given his approval on 08 October 2010.

Section 1 Scope

Heidelberg University charges tuition feeds to students enrolled in the non-consecutive Master in Advanced Physical Methods in Radiotherapy Program. Charges including the contribution to administration expenses according to Sec. 12 of the State Law Governing University, and Other Institutes of Higher Education Fees and contributions under the Act governing Student Services (Studentenwerksgesetz) shall remain unaffected.

Section 2 Amount of Tuition Fees

The tuition fee for full-time students shall be EUR 3,300 per semester; a reduced fee of EUR 1,000 shall be charged for the semester, in which the Master thesis will be submitted and defended.

Section 3 Payment Obligation

Any person who is seeking enrollment or who is already enrolled in the Master Program shall be required to pay the tuition fee.

Section 4 Due Date

The fee shall in each case be due and payable together with the request for enrollment or renewal. Details

will be provided in the notification of fees.

Section 5 Waiver

Upon request, the tuition fee may be waived as a whole or in part if collection would be unreasonable under the circumstances of the individual case. The Program Director will decide on any request for a waiver of fees upon consultation with the Dean of Studies of the Medical Faculty of Heidelberg.

Section 6 Effective Date

The present Statutes shall take effect on the day following their announcement in the Rector's newsletter
